6 x 12.7mm machineguns, 40–45 men.



6 x 20mm antiaircraft guns, 40 men.



3–4 120mm mortars, 40–45 men.



4 x 25mm antitank guns, 40–45 men.



6 x 40mm Bofors guns, 42 men. The largest AA gun used in the field. Larger used for home city defense.



30–40 men armed with rifles, SMGs, and a variety of antitank, demolition, and construction equipment



4 x 37mm antitank guns, 40–45 men.



6 x 75mm howitzers, 60–65 men.



30–40 men armed with rifles, SMGs, and a variety of antitank, demolition, and construction equipment.



6 x 45mm antitank guns, 40–50 men.



6 x 105mm howitzers, 100–110 men.



This unit represents the Panzerfaust and Panzerschrek armed antitank “bomber” units from 1944.



4 x 50mm antitank guns, 40–45 men.



6 x 155mm howitzers, 120 men.



40–45 men armed with rifles, 4 HMGs, 4 wagons, 13 horses.



4 x 75mm antitank guns, 40–45 men.



6 x 81 or 82mm mortars, 60–65 men, 15 wagons, 19 horses.



38 men armed with Mosin/Nagant rifles, 2 LMGs, 2 SMGs, 13 horses.
